

## Items Foster Home Will Need

- Capstar-For Fleas
- Crate (multiple, both large and small) Having the right size crates makes fostering much easier; having a crate in 2 or 3 places so you don't have to constantly be moving crates, makes it much easier. .
- Crate Pad - Crate Cover (old blanket or sheet)
- Car Harness-Must be using either a harness or a crate in the car
- 2 Belly Bands-different sizes- Incontinence Pads
- Piddle Pants (as needed, and if you do need them, you need at least 2 pair \$0 you have a dean one when the other is dirty,)
- Baby Clothes-for dogs with allergies
- Baby Gates
- 2-Dog leash {not needed but nice to have}
- Rescue Dog Tag
- Book: Scaredy Dog
- X-Pen (at least one)
- Rescue Dog Bandana or Coat
- Reliable vet who might be willing to give rescue discounts
- Good groomer willing to work with dogs who might have grooming issues
- Good cleanup equipment such as a cordless "spot lifter". (Makes all the difference in how hard it is to foster a dog needing housebreaking)
- We won't supply it but a camera is needed...maybe we could supply a throwaway but we really do want photos...before and after whenever possible.
- Note: If you do not have a fenced yard, you really should do something to provide a small penned area even if it is a couple of 4' ex-pens with stakes.
