## Discharge Instructions

for Molly Owner: Jean Story

### Post-Operative Instructions

The following information pertains to your pet's anesthesia, surgery, or dental.

# Spay and Dental with Extraction Discharge

Molly has been through a major abdominal surgery and dental with a tooth extraction. She will need special attention for a full, uneventful recovery, just as a human would. Please read and review the following instructions. If you have any questions at any time, please call **517-484-8031**.

<u>Activity</u>: No free running (must be on leash) or jumping for a minimum of 10-14 days, including outside time for going to the bathroom. No bathing or swimming for a minimum of 14 days after surgery. Try to restrict Molly's activity as much as possible for the next 2 weeks, you can do this by preventing access to steps, running and climbing.

<u>Diet:</u> You can resume Molly's normal diet as long as she is able to keep food in and doesn't exhibit signs of illness. Please soften her food with water or feed her canned for for the next 7 days to allow her tooth extraction site to heal.

Medications: Please continue Clavamox and every other day prednisone as previously prescribed.

- 1. Tramadol: For pain. Give 1/2 tablet twice daily as directed.
- 2. It is important not to give carprofen to Molly since she is on prednisone.

<u>Incision Care:</u> Please check the incision daily. Some redness and swelling is a normal consequence of surgery and healing. If the incision becomes painful, opens or discharges pus or blood, please call the clinic for a re-check. A small amount of clear fluid may ooze from the incision and is considered normal. DO NOT allow Molly to lick, chew, rub or pull at the incision. If she does, you must stop the behavior right away. There are no sutures to remove.

It is normal to see blood tinged saliva for a day or two following tooth extraction. Please feed Molly a softened diet for 7 days to allow the extraction site time to heal. The suture that was placed at the extraction site will dissolve on its own and does not need to be removed.

Special Instructions: There is a small blue knot at one end of the incision that is a dissolving suture and should go away within a couple of months, if it does not go away or causes any problems please call us 517-484-8031. There is a small amount of bruising around the incision area this should resolve within the next week if it gets worse or does not heal please call us 517-484-8031.
